### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT OVERDRAFTS AND OVERDRAFT FEES

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction. We can cover your over-drafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices that come with your account.
- 2. We also offer <u>overdraft protection plans</u>, such as a link to a savings account, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

## What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We do authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- · Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- · Automatic bill payments

We will not authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- · Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we do <u>not</u> authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

#### What fees will I be charged if AFL-CIO Employees Federal Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a fee of \$32.00 each time we pay an overdraft
- There is no limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account
